Reminders, Procedures, and Policies

Construction:

Maintenance/construction on the old gym will begin the week of summer school. It is imperative to the safety of our students, staff, and you the parent that we do use the black top area between the school and gym during this time. Drop off/pickup procedures listed below will explain how we are going to avoid that area.

Drop Off and Pick up:

Students being dropped off by parents in the morning will enter through the front doors of the elementary and make their way down to Godfrey Gymnasium. They will remain in the gym until 7:55 when they are escorted to their class by their teacher.

Parent pick up will take place under the awning in front of the elementary for grades K-3, 4-6 parents can pick their students up on the sidewalk that is between the elementary and special education building. During bad weather we will adjust accordingly. Parent pickup students can expect to be released at roughly 2:55.

Bus Procedures:

Students riding the bus to and from school will follow the same procedures that we adhere to during the regular school year. Bus drivers will be contacting each child's parent to notify them of pick up times before summer school begins.

Pickup Changes:

If your child's pick up procedure changes during the course of the day please call before 2:00pm in order for these changes to be made in our system. If you know ahead of time, please send a note.

Supplies:

Each student will be given a pack of crayons, dry erase marker, #2 pencils, and a glue stick.

Breakfast/Lunch:

Both will be served in the cafeteria. Breakfast starts at 7:30 and lunch will be served at 11:00. Both are free for anyone under the age of 18.

Incentives:

Students with perfect attendance for each will receive a reward on Friday of each week. Students with perfect attendance the entire session will have their names placed in a drawing for two \$50 dollar gift cards. It is very important that your child attends as much as he or she can not only for the incentives but also for educational growth!

Friday Field Trips:

We are still finalizing these plans as we speak. Notes will be sent home as soon as all of these are scheduled, permission slips will also go home to ensure you are comfortable with each activity. We are currently working on a movie day at the Lamar theatre, Soar, Pittsburg Water Park, and the Splash Pad in Webb City. Notes will also contain information on appropriate attire for the day as well.
