

Jasper School District Kindergarten Round-Up – Class of 2031!

We are attempting to “round-up” all incoming kindergarteners for the 2018-2019 school year. If you have or know a child who will be 5 years old before August 1, 2018, then this is important information for you!

Before a child can enter kindergarten, the state requires that we have a birth certificate and a record of his/her up to date immunizations. Either a hospital birth certificate or a certified copy is accepted. Your physician or health department can provide you with a record of your child’s immunizations. We will also require proof of residency. This can be a lease agreement, a utility bill or other documentation showing your physical address.

There will be a meeting held on Tuesday, March 6th beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the lobby of the Ken Godfrey Activity Center regarding kindergarten enrollment. **It is very important that parents have all their paperwork filled out and ready to turn in at round up night. Also, Please remember to bring your child’s birth certificate, shot record, social security card and proof of residency so that we can make copies of them.** Staff will be available beginning at 5:00 p.m. to make copies of all required documentation. Kindergarten Screening is scheduled for March 28th and 29th at the Baptist Church in Jasper. Screening times can be scheduled at the Round-Up meeting on March 6th.

Kindergarten Adventure Day is scheduled for April 13th and will begin at 10:15 a.m. in the Kindergarten classroom. Please turn in your RSVP letter for Adventure day during Round-Up-night.
