



Jasper R-V Student Health Self Assessment 2020-2021

The purpose of the Health Self Assessment is to help parents and guardians monitor the health of their children and make determinations on whether attendance at school is best practice.

Check boxes if any of the symptoms are present and are NOT explained by other health factors

- Fever or chills (fever over 100.3 or a rise of over .7 from normal body temperature) Please note that many children do NOT run a fever with COVID-19
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Been in close contact within the past two weeks with an individual with a confirmed case of COVID-19

If the parent or student answers YES to any of the screening questions, they should NOT report to school but call the appropriate school office to report the reason for non attendance and make contact with a health care practitioner for further guidance. Please be advised that Jasper R-V may do random temperature checks as part of our health and safety protocol.
