

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR SEALED BIDS FOR THE SALE OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE
JASPER R-V SCHOOL DISTRICT**

The School District of Jasper R-V has authorized the sale by sealed bid of the following surplus personal property in "as is condition" without any guarantees or representations of any kind:

1. 2007 Blue Bird, 72 Passenger Transit Bus
Cat Engine with Allison Transmission
161,220 miles
As Is. Injectors need replaced
Minimum bid: \$1,000
2. Small lot of preschool sized furniture.

All sealed bids must be submitted to the School Board Secretary in the following manner:

- a. The sealed bid must be in written form on plain paper and clearly state the name and address of the bidder, the item of surplus property which is the subject matter of the bid, the amount of the bid being made, and must be signed and dated by the bidder.
- b. The bid must be for not less than the minimum amount shown for the item bid upon.
- c. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid deposit of five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.
- d. The bid must be placed and sealed in an opaque envelope and presented in person to the Board Secretary at the Jasper R-V Superintendent's Office, 201 W. Mercer, Jasper, MO 64755 prior to 5 p.m. local time, Friday, October 9, 2020.
- e. The envelope containing the sealed bid must be clearly marked on the front with the specific name of the item of personal property for which the bid is submitted and with no other information on the face of said envelope.
- f. A bid deposit may take the form of a cashier's check, a certified check, or money order. The deposit of the bidder to whom the award is made will be held until sale of the property is closed; if that bidder refused at any time to close the sale, the deposit will be forfeited to the School District of Jasper R-V. The deposits of the other bidders will be returned at the time the School District Board of Education awards the property to the highest responsible bidder.
- g. In order for a bid to be considered, the bidder must be current on payment of all property taxes owed to the county of bidder's residence.

The School District will accept sealed bids for the sale of said personal property until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, October 9, 2020 at the Superintendent's office, 201 W. Mercer,

Jasper, MO 64755—at which time the said sealed bids will be opened in public by the Board Secretary or such other School District official as designated by the School Board President.

- At that time, all bidders who have submitted bids as above stated shall have the opportunity to raise their bids until such time as no other higher bid is made by any qualified bidder present.
- The highest final bid on each item of personal property shall be delivered by the Board Secretary or her designee to the School Board during the regular meeting of the School Board on October 26, 2020.
- The School Board reserves the right to withdraw the property from sale at any time and reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
- The successful bidder must pay in full for the item purchased and remove such item within ten (10) business days of the acceptance of such bidder's bid.
- The School District of Jasper R-V reserves the right to waive any irregularities in the bidding process.
- In the event that the high bidder defaults on said purchase, the District hereby reserves the right to accept the bid of the next highest bidder.
